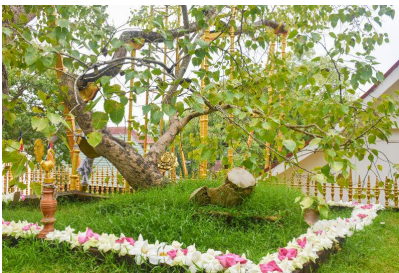
Anuradhapura

Carved in the Indian Gupta style, the sculpture is a real couple who lived in the past. This is according to folklore. Some say that this is the son of king Dutugemunu who left his right to the throne of the Anuradhapura Kingdom for a girl from a low caste. Though this temple was constructed by the king Dewanampiyathissa, the history of the temple runs back to 5000 years, and it is said the great king Ravana was born here. With a great history, the place Isurumuni rock temple attracts visitors in thousands

every year. Make sure to throw a coin to the elephant pond at the temple to make a wish of yours come true

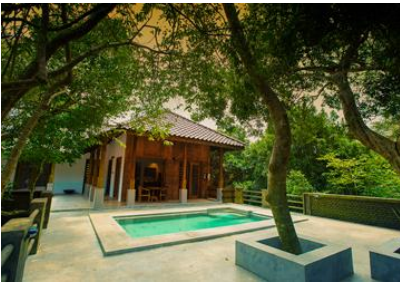
Hotels
